

RAPHAEL BUILDING INSTRUCTIONS




READ BEFORE ASSEMBLING:

- Go through the instructions one step at a time.
- Don't punch out all of the pre-cut parts at once.
 Plywood thickness and color may vary.

- While not necessary, glue may be applied if desired.
 If you have trouble punching out the small pieces from the board, use tweezers or a toothpick to help.
- · Adult supervision recommended





MAKE IT YOUR OWN

Before you start building and decorating your model, read through the instructions so you understand how it all comes together. Then make a plan. Do you want to cover Raphael in sewer slime? What about making him pizza-themed? The choice is yours!

PLAN

For this project, assemble the model except for the arms, the legs, and the two sai, Paint those separately and then put them together once they are dry.

TECHNIQUES

Paint the pieces carefully. Use a small detail brush for the eyes, mouth, and bandanna.



For a replica, a nice bright green, medium yellow, and brown will be good paints to choose. And don't forget Raphael's signature red!

ACCESSORIZE


Use an ink pen to draw in the pupils in Raphael's eyes. You can use silver paint or marker to color the sai.




