
NUTCRACKER BUILDING INSTRUCTIONS

READ BEFORE ASSEMBLING:

- Go through the instructions one step at a time.
- Don't punch out all of the pre-cut parts at once.
- Plywood thickness and color may vary.
- While not necessary, glue may be applied if desired.
- If you have trouble punching out the small pieces from the board, use tweezers or a toothpick to help.
- Adult supervision recommended.





MAKE IT YOUR OWN

Before you start building and decorating your model, make a plan. Do you want to make a replica of the project below or create something of your own design? Anything goes!

PLAN

For this project, you will want to paint a few pieces separate from the model: hat, face, sword, and base.

TECHNIQUES

Use different sized of paintbrushes for different needs. You'll want a larger brush for the larger sections of color such as the hat, base, and pants. You should use a medium brush for the smaller sections, like the coat, hair, and boots. Use the tiniest brush you can find for the details on the face and coat.




COLORS

Classic holiday colors such as red, green, and gold are perfect for the iconic nutcracker. But don't forget basic black and white either. A light peach color will look nice for the face.





















To put the two pieces together, match up the slots on each piece. Slide toghether.
