


### READ BEFORE ASSEMBLING:

- Go through the instructions one step at a time. Don't punch out all of the precut parts at once.
  Plywood thickness and color may vary.
- While not necessary, glue may be applied if desired.
- If you have trouble punching out the small pieces from the board, use tweezers or a toothpick to help.
- Adult supervision recommended.





# MAKE IT YOUR OWN

Before you start building and decorating your model, make a plan. Do you want to make a traditional reindeer or create something of your own design? Anything goes!

## PLAN

For this project, it's best to assemble the entire model before painting it.

#### COLORS


Various shades of brown were used to make the sample shown here, but feel free to mix it up. Why not try a red reindeer?



## **TECHNIQUES**

Start by painting the main body of the model a solid color. Make sure you get into all the nooks and crannies. Next, paint the antlers and the hooves. Finish by adding details like the eyes and nose.


