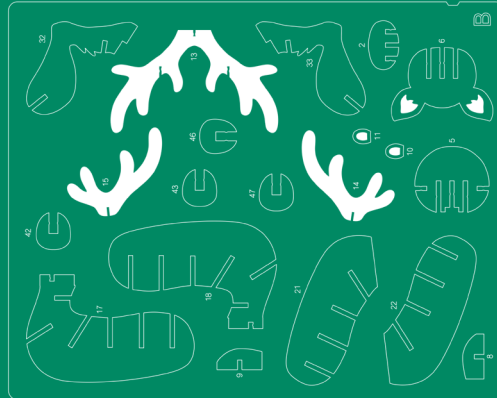
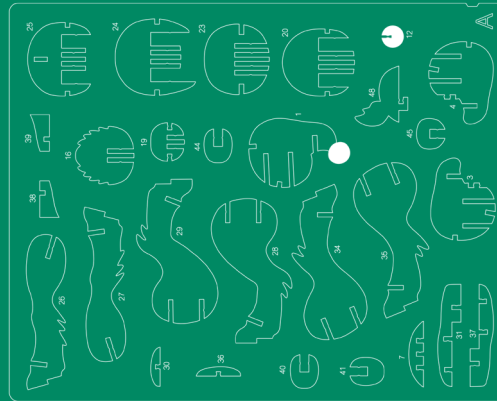
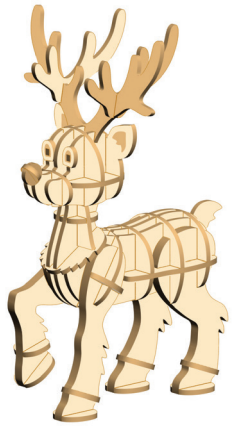

READ BEFORE ASSEMBLING:

- Go through the instructions one step at a time.
- Don't punch out all of the pre-cut parts at once.
- Plywood thickness and color may vary.
- While not necessary, glue may be applied if desired.
- If you have trouble punching out the small pieces from the board, use tweezers or a toothpick to help.
- Adult supervision recommended.

PLAN

For this project, it's best to assemble the entire model before painting it.

COLORS

Various shades of brown were used to make the sample shown here, but feel free to mix it up. Why not try a red reindeer?

TECHNIQUES

Start by painting the main body of the model a solid color. Make sure you get into all the nooks and crannies. Next, paint the antlers and the hooves. Finish by adding details like the eyes and nose.

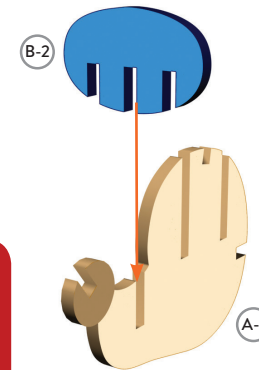
Find pieces 1 and 2 on the board.

Pop out only these puzzle pieces from the board.

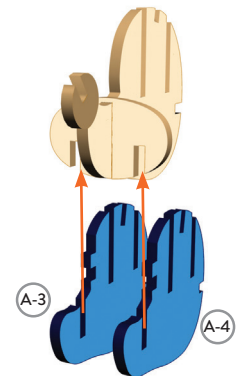

To put two pieces together, match up the slots on each piece. Slide together.

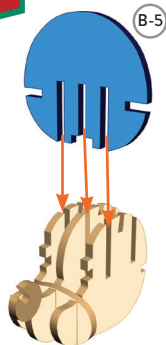

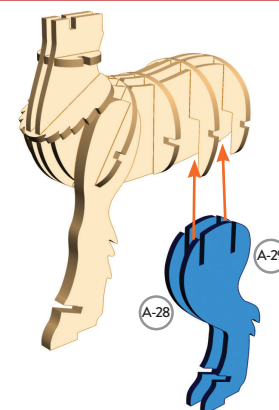
One side of piece 24 is slightly longer than the other. Make sure the longer side is closest to you when you're attaching piece 24 at the angle shown.

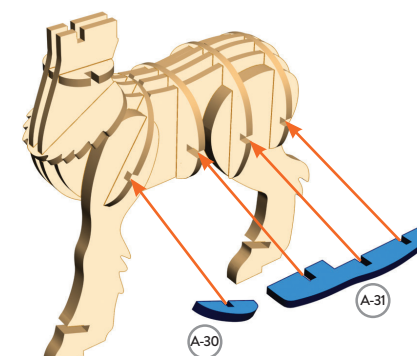
Pieces 26 and 27 should both slide side-by-side into the same slot.

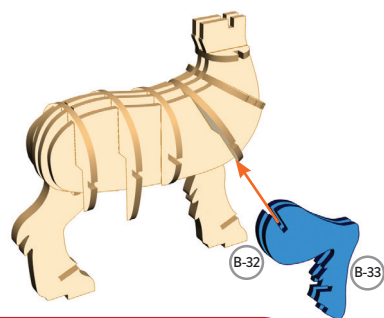


Pieces 28 and 29 should both slide side-by-side into the same slot.

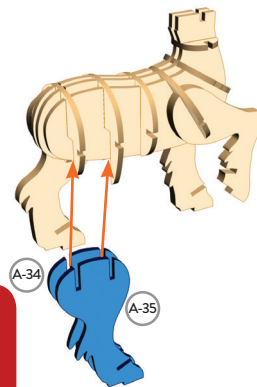

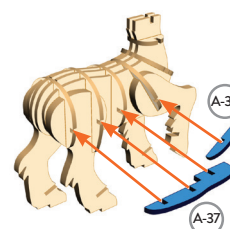
Pieces 32 and 33 should both slide side-by-side into the same slot.

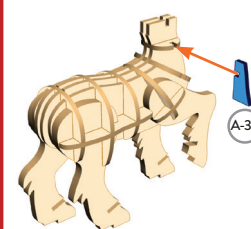


Pieces 34 and 35 should both slide side-by-side into the same slot.

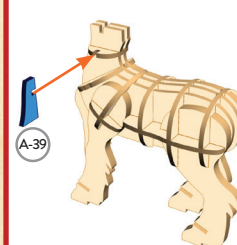
