

SNOWFLAKE BUILDING INSTRUCTIONS

READ BEFORE ASSEMBLING:

- Go through the instructions one step at a time.
- Don't punch out all of the precut parts at once.
- Plywood thickness and color may vary.
- While not necessary, glue may be applied if desired.
- If you have trouble punching out the small pieces from the board, use tweezers or a toothpick to help.
- Adult supervision recommended.








MAKE IT YOUR OWN

Before you start building and decorating your model, make a plan. These snowflakes are perfect for breaking out your craft collection from glitter to gems! Here are three ideas to get you started, but remember—anything goes!

ICY SNOWFLAKE

- Start by painting the entire snowflake white. You may want two coats of white paint to cover all the wood.
- 2. Use a very fine paintbrush to outline the snowflake with ice blue paint.
- 3. Add extra flair to the design on the front by using glitter paint.



SILVER SPARKLES

- 1. Start by painting the entire snowflake silver.
- 2. Use an old paintbrush to paint a thin layer of glue over the front of the snowflake.
- 3. Pour glitter over the glue and tap off the excess into a trash can.
- 4. If you want another glitter color, wait until the first is dry and then repeat steps 2 and 3.

WINTER WONDERLAND

1. Start by painting the trees green.

2. Using a fine paintbrush, start adding detail to the front and back of the snowflake. Start with any white paint details.

3. Add colors working from light to dark.

4. Finish with any black details.
