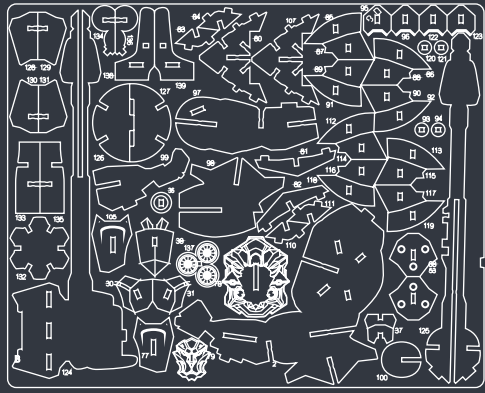
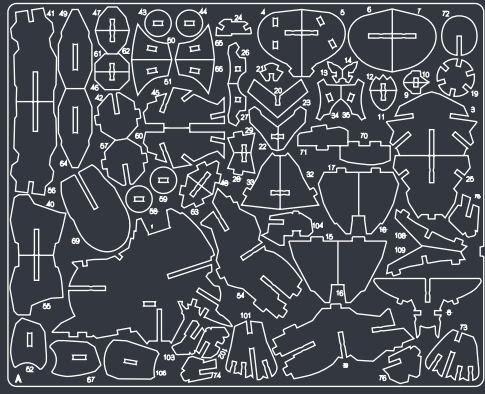

BUILDING INSTRUCTIONS

READ BEFORE ASSEMBLING:

- Go through the instructions one step at a time.
- Don't punch out all of the precut parts at once.
- Plywood thickness and color may vary.
- While not necessary, glue may be applied if desired.
- If you have trouble punching out the small pieces from the board, use tweezers or a toothpick to help.
- Adult supervision recommended.

MAKE IT YOUR OWN

Before you start building and decorating your model, make a plan. Do you want to make an exact replica of the project below or create something of your own design? Anything goes!

PLAN

For this project, it's easier to paint Reinhardt partially disassembled. Separate his arms, legs, rocket hammer, and barrier field shield. Just be careful not to paint too heavily around any slots or tabs so that the pieces still fit back together easily.

TECHNIQUE

Study the image shown and other reference images very carefully. Use a fine paintbrush and take your time, especially for the small details. For brighter colors, try painting the whole model with a light gray primer first.



COLOR

Start by using a pencil and a reference image to trace where all the silver features meet the dark gray ones. Guided by your pencil lines, paint in the silver and gray areas. The silver may take multiple coats before it has a more metallic shine to it. Next, find all the areas on the model that should be yellow and paint them white before adding the coat of yellow paint. This will give these areas a brighter, more glowing effect. For the parts on Reinhardt's hammer and back that should be fierier, add some orange edges around the yellow. Finally, finish off your model by adding the red accents around Reinhardt's armor.
