




READ BEFORE ASSEMBLING:

- Go through the instructions one step at a time.Don't punch out all of the precut parts at once.

MAKE IT YOUR OWN

Before you start building and decorating your model, make a plan. Do you want to make an exact replica of the project below or create something with your own Gryffindor flair? Anything goes!

PLAN

For this project, it's easiest to paint your model with all the layers of wood separated.

TECHNIQUES

Use a fine paintbrush and take your time, especially with the smaller engraved details. To give your model more depth, use darker shades of paint for shadows and lighter shades for highlights.




the diamonds there red. Then, paint the upper right and lower left quadrants red. Paint the diamonds there black. Use yellow to paint the outer frame of the crest as well as the outline of the banner. Fill in the interior of the banner with cream paint. The square with the G of Gryffindor should be painted red and all of the letters black.


To add some finishing touches to the banner and frame, outline the edges and fill in the outer diamonds with a very light brown. Add black to the other flourishes. Finally, paint the lion using brown for the mane and various shades of yellow for the body, then add white for the teeth and black for the nose and eye.











Continue assembling by putting pieces together in numerical order.
