
### **HUFFLEPUFF BUILDING INSTRUCTIONS**



### **READ BEFORE ASSEMBLING:**

- Go through the instructions one step at a time.
- Don't punch out all of the precut parts at once.
- Plywood thickness and color may vary.
  While not necessary, glue may be applied if desired.
- If you have trouble punching out the small pieces from the board, use tweezers or a toothpick to help.
- Adult supervision recommended.





# MAKE IT YOUR OWN

Before you start building and decorating your model, make a plan. Do you want to make an exact replica of the project below or create something with your own Hufflepuff flair? Anything goes!

## PLAN

For this project, it's easiest to paint your model with all the layers of wood separated.

#### TECHNIOUES A

Use a fine paintbrush and take your time, especially with the smaller engraved details. To give your model more depth, use darker shades of paint for shadows and lighter shades for highlights.



### COLORS

Start by painting the background of the crest a solid vellow, and then fill in every other stripe as well as the dots and symbols with black paint or a fine permanent pen. You can add some shading with a slightly darker yellow, but make sure the black is completely dry before painting over it. Next, paint the banner the same color yellow as the background, using the darker yellow for more shading. Fill in the Hufflepuff letters in black using a fine paintbrush or pen. The frame of the crest should be black with a lighter gray for highlights. Finally, paint the badger black and white, adding details with various shades of gray. Emphasize the tinier details with a fine pen.















To put the two pieces together, match up the slots on each piece. Slide together.
